



## Course Title: Defensive Driving – Blacktop (LV)

<b>Target Audience:</b>	The course is designed for all employees who drive a motor vehicle within the Sultanate of Oman and the surrounding GCC region.
<b>Aims:</b>	To enhance drivers knowledge and skills for driving safely on blacktop roads within the Sultanate of Oman and the surrounding GCC region.
<b>Objectives:</b>	<p>By the end of this session, the delegate will have an understanding of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Perform all pre-driving checks.</li><li>• Drive the vehicle safely, lawfully, and correctly whilst interacting with other traffic.</li><li>• Keep a safe distance on all sides of the vehicle in all traffic conditions.</li><li>• Observe, recognise, and correctly respond to all potential and actual hazards, and use the correct elements of the hazard approach procedure.</li><li>• Observe, recognise and correctly respond to all road features, signs, signals and markings.</li><li>• Communicate correctly and appropriately with other road users.</li><li>• Drive the vehicle at a speed and in a manner commensurate with the condition of the load, road, traffic, and environmental conditions.</li><li>• Understand the main causes of road collisions and road traffic law relevant to safe driving throughout the Sultanate of Oman. (For Oman only)</li><li>• Understand additional hazards which can be encountered when driving at night and in a wide variety of 'bad weather conditions'.</li><li>• Manoeuvre safely and efficiently in a restricted space.</li><li>• Think and act 'defensively'. This is the key component and forms the basis of the course. Safe use of all controls is important; but this course focuses on the all-important perceptive skills i.e. the driver's thought processes, which are developed to a high level by means of encouragement, quality instruction and commentary driving by the instructor and trainees.</li></ul>
<b>Assessment:</b>	Our assessment process is carried out using a range of methods: Observations, Questions, Demonstration, Simulation, however it's about our instructor feeling safe.
