



## Course Title: Defensive Driving - OXY Graded Road - Foundation (HV)

<b>Target Audience:</b>	The course is designed for employees who are required to drive a Heavy Vehicle on graded roads within OXY concessions in the Sultanate of Oman
<b>Aim:</b>	To enhance drivers knowledge and skills for safely driving a Heavy Vehicle within OXY concessions in the Sultanate of Oman
<b>Objectives:</b>	<p>By the end of this session, the delegate will have an understanding of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Perform all pre-driving checks</li><li>▪ Drive the vehicle safely, lawfully, and correctly whilst interacting with other traffic</li><li>▪ Keep a safe distance on all sides of the vehicle in all traffic conditions</li><li>▪ Observe, recognise, and correctly respond to all potential and actual hazards, and use the correct elements of the hazard approach procedure</li><li>▪ Observe, recognise and correctly respond to all road features, signs, signals and markings</li><li>▪ Communicate correctly and appropriately with other road users</li><li>▪ Understand additional hazards which driving at night (with permission)</li><li>▪ Manoeuvre safely and efficiently in a restricted space</li><li>▪ Describe the unique handling characteristics of Heavy Vehicles and loads on graded roads</li><li>▪ Describe the actions a Heavy Vehicle driver should take in the event of an emergency situation</li><li>▪ Describe the road layouts and features where Heavy Vehicles are most at risk of a road traffic collision</li><li>▪ Explain how the handling characteristics of heavy vehicles, harsh driving styles and different road conditions can affect vehicle control.</li><li>▪ Understand the key regulations for driving in OXY concessions</li><li>▪ Recover and escape from the initial stage of the 'S' pattern rollover</li><li>▪ Understand the main causes of road collisions on graded roads</li></ul>





	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Identify, reduce and control the hazards encountered whilst driving on graded roads</li><li>• Be aware of the dangers of 'camel hits' and collisions with other animals</li><li>• Have an awareness of IVMS</li><li>• Think and act 'defensively'. This is the key component and forms the basis of the course. Safe use of all controls is, of course, important; but this course focuses on the all-important perceptive skills i.e. the driver's thought processes, which are developed to a high level by means of encouragement, quality instruction and commentary driving by the instructor and trainees</li></ul>
<b>Assessment:</b>	Our assessment process is carried out using a range of methods: Observations, Questions, Demonstration and Simulation. However, it's about our instructor feeling safe
<b>Prerequisites:</b>	Aged 21 years or over Hold a valid ROP/GCC driving licence for a heavy vehicle
<b>Certification:</b>	A permit to drive a Heavy Vehicles in OXY concessions within the Sultanate of Oman will be issued upon successful completion of the course
<b>Duration:</b>	6 hours
<b>Validity:</b>	2 years
